

# KOKOMO

## 13-16% DM

Kokomo is a mono-germ fodder beet variety that has a bulb dry matter percentage range of 13-16%.

Kokomo has a large red tankard shaped bulb that sits approximately 50%+ above the ground with good disease and bolting tolerance. The crop can be grazed in-situ by all stock types.



## Agronomic traits

- Bulb percentage above ground: +/- 50%
- Dry matter percentage: 13-16% \*
- Disease tolerance: Very good \*
- Sowing season: Spring
- Sowing rate (seeds/ha): 90,000-100,000
